1. DISCUSS SNOW REMOVAL ON LIBERTY AND LONDON RD

A. WATERMAIN BREAKS

Doyle informed the Committee that there was a 12” watermain break at the intersection of S. Main Street and Simonson Street and that a valve, in the same area, also broke. Forest Landscape and Public Work staff repaired the break and the road will be blacktopped once the plants open.

B. WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT – HIGH STREET

Doyle updated the committee on the watermain replacement on High Street. The Village has purchased the material but the contractor is concerned that his backhoe will slip on the hill due to the frost.

Lemke questioned if the Emerald Ash Borer has been detected in the Village and Doyle informed him that it was on N. Atwood Lane.
